

**INQUESTS ARISING FROM THE DEATHS
IN THE WESTMINSTER TERROR ATTACK OF 22 MARCH 2017**

AGENDA FOR PRE-INQUEST HEARING ON 19 MAY 2017

1. Designation of interested persons in relation to:
 - (a) the inquests of the four persons who died as a result of the attack on the bridge (Kurt Cochran, Leslie Rhodes, Andreea Cristea and Aysha Frade);
 - (b) the inquest of PC Keith Palmer; and
 - (c) the inquest of Khalid Masood.

2. Update on the police and IPCC investigations into the events of the attack.

3. Arrangements for provision of documents from the investigation (statements, exhibits, other documents and audio-visual material) to the Coroner.

4. Arrangements for disclosure by the Coroner to interested persons.

5. Initial discussion of further case management and legal issues:
 - (a) The organisation of the inquests, for example whether (i) all are to be heard together, (ii) the inquests of all the victims are to be heard separately from the inquest of Khalid Masood or (iii) there are to be three separate inquest hearings concerning the victims on the bridge, PC Palmer and Khalid Masood.
 - (b) The possible scope of the inquests.
 - (c) Which inquests have to be heard, or ought to be heard, with a jury.
 - (d) In which of the inquests the state's procedural obligation under Article 2, ECHR, may be engaged.
 - (e) Applications for anonymity and screening / special measures.
 - (f) Handling of any public interest immunity applications.
 - (g) Possible time and venue for the inquests, and logistical arrangements.
 - (h) Further pre-inquest hearings.
